CONDITIONS OF SALE

Full details of our sale horses can be found on the attached sheet and also individually on their stable doors. The description outlines the breeding, age and stage of training of each horse together with a price guide. The price guide is the MINIMUM amount for which the horse will be sold on the day of the sale. Buyers are invited to view the horses pre sale and also on the sale day. If you are interested in purchasing a particular horse, you must make your BEST OFFER in writing on the attached BUYERS SLIP and lodge this at the office in one of the sealed envelopes provided, no later than 5.00pm on the sale day. At the end of this time, all offers submitted will be opened and the horse will be sold to the person submitting the HIGHEST OFFER for that particular horse, PROVIDED THAT OFFER IS ON OR OVER ITS GUIDE PRICE. Please note, there is NO BUYERS PREMIUM or VAT (unless stated) to be added to the OFFER Price if you are successful bidder.

Once an offer is made, it is legally binding, and the successful purchaser will be notified by telephone the same day soon after 5.00pm and will be required to immediately lodge a 10% deposit payment. This deposit will be refunded in full if the horse does not pass a full five stage vetting. Requests for veterinary examination, if required, must be made to the sale office on the same day as sale, and will be carried out at the purchaser's expense by Spring Paddocks Equine Clinic on the Monday/Tuesday following the sale Day. The veterinary examination will be valid for the date and time of the examination only and the decision of the veterinary surgeon carrying out the examination shall be final and binding between seller and purchaser. The Sport Horse Centre shall not be liable for the findings of the veterinary surgeon. Should a potential purchaser wish to arrange for x ray examination of a particular horse, this will be at his or her own expensive and must be requested and completed prior to auction. If X rays have already been taken of an individual horse they will be lodged for viewing at the office.

The Sport Horse Centre may, at their discretion, refuse to accept any offer and may add or withdraw horses, cancel or postpone any sale or trial day and will not be liable to pay compensation to any party in this eventuality.

No horse will be allowed to leave the sale premises until full payment of cleared funds is received.. Horses will remain stabled at The Sport Horse Centre at the purchasers risk at a cost of £40.00 per day until settlement is received. All horses purchased must be paid for and collected within 5 working days.

Horses purchased, shall be at the risk of the buyer, once the successful buyer has been notified and we strongly advise buyers to arrange immediate insurance cover. No pedigrees/passports or ownership titles will be forwarded to the purchaser until cleared payment has been received.

All persons riding at The Sport Horse Centre must at all times wear a hard riding hat of a current approved standard and suitable riding clothes and footwear. All persons handling horses on the premises must wear suitable protective clothing and footwear. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. No persons may enter any stable without prior permission from centre staff. No persons are allowed to use any of the trial facilities at The Sport Horse Centre without prior approval from the office. Should potential buyers or their associates wish to ride any of the sale horses we advise attending the preview days. The Sport Horse Centre and its associate sellers will clearly state the level of training of the horses offered for sale, we strongly recommend that buyers or their associates consider the current level and standard of their riding capability and only request to try sale horses commensurate with their capability. The Sport Horse Centre reserves the right to refuse any prospective purchaser or associate a ridden trial of any sale horse.

The buyer must notify The Sport Horse Centre by 5.00pm on the second day following the sale day, if the buyer claims to be entitled to return the horse as mis-described in relation to pedigree or description as per the catalogue, even if the sale horse is still on the Sport Horse Centre premises at the second day following the sale day. Oral notification must be followed up in writing setting out the reasons why the buyer claims to be entitled to return the horse to the seller, accompanied where appropriate with a veterinary certificate confirming any veterinary matters in respect of the complaint. Failure to supply such a certificate will mean that the buyers complaint cannot further be considered. In no circumstances may the time limit be extended beyond seven days.

All persons attending The Sport Horse Centre and this sale, do so entirely at their own risk. The Sport Horse Centre does not accept any responsibility whatsoever for any injury to horses, animals or people attending, or any responsibility for any damages or losses to vehicles or property.
